## Application & Training

- Applications are available on our website: [kingcountymg.org](http://kingcountymg.org) each year on August 1st and due by the posted October deadline.
- Training is one day a week for 12 weeks beginning in mid-January.
- Tuition is approximately \$300, with scholarships available.
- Trainees study a wide range of horticultural topics, with online and in-class coursework.
- Email and high-speed internet required.

## Volunteer Commitment

- Trainees must complete 40 hours of volunteer service in their first year and 25 hours per year thereafter.
- Most volunteer activities take place on weekends from spring to early fall.
