





Master Gardener Plant Sale 2019: Parking Update

Volunteer, vendor, and guest parking at the Center for Urban Horticulture (CUH) for this year's Spring Plant Sale is unchanged from 2018, but different from the years before that. Please review the map and this information before you arrive.



NO PARKING–The grassy area behind the Greenhouse

- NO PARKING in the grassy parking area used by volunteers and vendors in the past. You will be stopped at the entry. This area will be held for plant pick-up and disability parking only.
- If you are making a delivery either Friday or Saturday morning, you will be allowed **brief** access.



NO PARKING–All neighborhoods north of CUH

- CUH has asked that we help prevent parking in the neighborhood immediately NE of the grounds – meaning NE 42nd and NE 43rd Streets and 36th NE and 37th NE Avenues. This area will be signed “No Plant Sale Parking” Friday and Saturday.
- It will be OK to park just beyond CUH, farther east down NE 41st Street, and on Surber Drive NE or other neighborhoods south or east of 41st.



PRIMARY PARKING AREA FOR VOLUNTEERS AND VENDORS

- Immediately after turning onto Mary Gates Drive from Sand Point Way, before it curves and becomes 41st Street, look for NE Clark Road on the right. Turn right onto Clark Road and follow the signs to **LOT E4**, which has been reserved for vendors and volunteers; 100 parking spaces have been paid for.
- Do not enter the area marked “Customer Parking”, just before LOT E4.
- On Saturday, if LOT E4 is full, drive farther down Clark Road to **Lot E1**, which will be available as overflow parking on SATURDAY ONLY.
 - Lot E1, farther down Clark Road, will be staffed by a UW Parking attendant on Saturday. Inform the attendant that you’re going to the Plant Sale; you may park at no charge.
 - No parking near the Ceramic and Metal Arts Building (Lot E3) after turning onto Clark Road or in Lot E14 near the golf driving range.
- Master Gardeners: No parking on the Knoll (reserved for customers).



CUSTOMER PARKING

- Customers will park on “The Knoll”, within walking distance of the sale, or along 41st Street. The Knoll area will be signed, and staffed with parking attendants.

CARPPOOL with other Master Gardeners who are working similar shifts to reduce the number of cars looking for parking. PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION is also a good choice, including the [bus](#). King County Metro bus route 78 stops right in front of the Center for Urban Horticulture on NE 41st Street. Metro bus routes 25, 65, and 75 stop at NE 45th Street and Mary Gates Memorial Drive NE. Route 67 stops at NE 45th and Montlake Boulevard NE.
