Subject: Plant Sale Announcement

To: Master Gardeners and Interns of King County,

We want to let you know of a King County Master Gardener plant sale opportunity, based on a clarification by Governor Inslee's office. They have cleared Master Gardeners for vegetable plant sales provided all Health Dept guidelines are followed. We have been officially deemed an essential activity as it pertains to food distribution.

We are going to offer for sale the veggie starts planted at Bellevue Demonstration Garden (BDG) and Cesar Chavez Demonstration Garden (CCDG), that were intended for sale at our regular plant sales. These sales will be virtual, in that you will order the veggie types you want on-line, and pick them up, pre-selected, at that location you ordered them from. You will be asked to select a specific date and time to pick up your order.

Preliminary info for BDG - pick-up dates/times are Wed, 4/29, Sat. 5/2 and Wed, 5/6. Veggie types offered are tomatoes, tomatillos, ground cherry, summer and winter squash, cucumber, peas, peppers, salad greens, borage, bronze fennel, anise hyssop, stevia, basil, melons and eggplant.

Preliminary info for CCDG - pickup date/times are Sat, May 2, Sun., May 3, Sat., May 9 and Sun, May 10. Veggie types offered are tomatoes, broccoli, cabbage, collards, kale, leek, onion, eggplant, ground cherry, chard, peppers, lettuce, celtuce

Detailed information will be provided near the end of the week of April 20.
